Dear Parish Family,

This week, we celebrate the Memorial of St. Maximilian Kolbe, one of my patron saints, and the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. St. Maximilian Kolbe was a Polish Franciscan, who remained in his monastery during the Nazi occupation of Poland. There, Kolbe took in refugees, established a hospital, and eventually published anti-Nazi publications.

In 1941, he was arrested and sent to Auschwitz, where he ministered to his fellow inmates. When the guards selected ten people to be starved because someone escaped, Kolbe volunteered to die in the place of one of the ten. While in solitary confinement, Kolbe led the others in prayer and hymns to Mary. He is considered a martyr and had a strong devotion to Mary.

He technically died on August 15<sup>th</sup>, however, that is the Solemnity of the Assumption. So, his memorial is moved to the 14<sup>th</sup>. How appropriate that the Apostle of Mary died on the celebration of her Assumption. This great Solemnity reminds us that Mary was assumed both body and soul into heaven. Both days should remind us that our end goal is not here on earth. That our joy is not found in any earthly possessions or desires. We are made for eternity! Let's strive each day to reach that goal.

Our mass schedule is the following: 6 p.m. on Monday at St. Michael, 8 a.m. (School Mass) and 12:05 p.m. at St. Joseph. We will not have the regularly scheduled daily mass on Tuesday evening. Come celebrate this holy day with us!
