September is the Month of Our Lady of Sorrows—The Church dedicates the month of September to Our Lady of Sorrows, also known as Mater Dolorosa. This devotion recalls the Blessed Virgin Mary's spiritual martyrdom in virtue of her perfect union with the Passion of Christ. This was her role in salvation history, and what merited her place as the spiritual Mother of all Christians. This is symbolized by a single sword, or seven swords, piercing Mary's suffering heart, as foretold in Simeon's prophecy. The feast day is September 15th, you may pick up a rosary chaplets next weekend in church or at the church office.

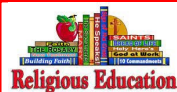
