Dear Parish Family,

The Season of Advent has finally begun! We may have Christmas parties scheduled, Christmas music playing, and maybe we even have our Christmas decoration up. But it isn't quite Christmas yet! Be sure to enter Advent as we prepare for Christ's birth and celebrate it during the entire Christmas Season, which ends on January 6th with the celebration of the Epiphany.

Christmas Day falls on a Monday this year. This means that we must attend Holy Mass for the 4th Sunday of Advent *and* Christmas. There are a few options. Our weekend mass for the 4th Sunday of Advent remains the same. Our Christmas Masses are the following:

Sunday – Christmas Vigil Masses: 4pm at St. Joseph and 6pm at St. Michael

Monday - Christmas Day Masses: Midnight and 9am at St. Joseph

Our Sunday obligation can be fulfilled by any masses on Saturday evening or any time on Sunday. So, yes, going to Mass at 6pm on Sunday "counts" for Sunday, even though the prayers and readings are for Christmas Eve. The Christmas Obligation can be fulfilled by any Mass after 4pm on Sunday. If Christ can come to earth, suffer, die, and rise from the dead for us then we can attend two masses for Him.

As I have mentioned in past letters, we have our upcoming Advent Mission, and the theme will be on sacred silence and entering the Advent Season. It will be December 6th, 13th, and 20th and start at 5p.m. After each mission there will be Light is on For You Confessions ending around 8 p.m. Please come out and attend the Advent Mission, it will be a great opportunity to quit down during such a busy time of the year! We also had a successful first session of the book study!

Throughout the Season of Advent, I hope to focus on the Sacrament of Confession. I will use these letters and my homilies to unpack this important Sacrament. This time of the year is so focused on giving gifts, decorating, attending parties, family, and so on. My challenge to all of you, including myself, is to come up with a gift for Christ. What is something that you can give Him?

Well, we know that the main reason Christ came to Earth was to free us from our sins. So, one of the greatest gifts we can give Him is by going to the Sacrament of Confession before approaching Him in the manger at Christmas. Give Christ your sins, your weaknesses, and He will transform you. This is primarily accomplished through the Sacrament of Confession. Everyone, even priests and the Pope, must go to Confession. It is a Sacrament of healing and mercy, something we all need!

I have provided what's known as an Examination of Conscience. It is a detailed list of questions that we ask ourselves *before* going to Confession. It allows us to reflect and know what to confess. This one uses the Seven Deadly Sins as that starting point but there are plenty of different kinds out there. Have a blessed Advent Season!
