#### Dear Parish Family,

Today, the Church celebrates the Epiphany of the Lord. The manifestation of Christ to the Magi, who followed the star and traveled from afar to see Him. This visitation of the Magi shows Christ's revelation to the Gentile Nations, those who were not part of the Jewish faith. His birth is often seen as His manifestation to the Jewish People, while Epiphany celebrates His revelation to the entire world. It is a custom in the Church to bless Epiphany chalk and use that chalk to mark and bless the door of your home. It places God at the entrance of your home and asks for His protection. I have blessed some Epiphany chalk and invite everyone to take one home and use the following prayer:

## How to Bless your Home with Epiphany Chalk:

At the front door of your home (or any other door) say:

Leader: Peace be to this house.

Everyone: And to all who dwell herein.

Leader: From the east came the Magi to Bethlehem to adore the Lord; and opening their treasures they offered precious gifts: gold for the great King, incense for the true God, and myrrh in symbol of His burial.

*Take the chalk and write the following above the door:* 20 + C + M + B + 24

Leader: May all who come to our home this year rejoice to find Christ living among us; and may we seek and serve, in everyone we meet, that same Jesus who is Lord, forever and ever. Amen.

The 20 and 24 at the beginning and ends stands for the year and the letters represent the traditional names of the three Magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar. It also stands for Christus Mansionem Benedicat, which means "May Christ Bless this House."

The following day we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord in the Jordan River by St. John the Baptist. Though Christ was sinless and did not need to be baptized. He was baptized as a reminder for all of us who do need to be baptized. This celebration marks the end of the Christmas Season and beginning of Ordinary Time.

Also, on January 20th we will have a Pro-Life Walk in our community. It begins at 10 a.m. at St. Francis and ends around 3 p.m. Please help us spread the word regarding this amazing opportunity to speak for those who cannot speak for themselves and gather as a community to pray.
