Dear Parish Family,

As you entered church today, you may have noticed the statues covered in purple veils. It is a common practice to cover all the statues during the period of Passiontide, which consists of the last two weeks of Lent. Veiling reminds us that we are shifting our focus from Christ in the desert to Christ during His Passion.

But why cover up something beautiful? First, the veils alert us of the special time we are in. When we walk into the church, we immediately know something is different. Second, the veils focus our attention on what's happening before us: the mass and the narrative of Christ's Passion read on Palm Sunday. Third, the Church uses veils to produce a heighted sense of anticipation for Easter. We don't want the veils to be there because they are hiding something beautiful.

Here, we see the whole point coming together: the veils are not meant to be there forever. The images will have to be unveiled; it is almost unnatural for these statues and images to be covered. They were made to show God's grandeur. The unveiling before Easter then acts as a reminder of our own life here on earth. Just as Christ broke the veil between life and death, we too will go beyond the veil. Veiling is a beautiful example of our faith being expressed in tangible, physical things.

Please mark on your calendars our celebration on March 19th in honor of St. Joseph. We will have mass at 8 a.m. with a blessing of our St. Joseph Altar in the hall. There will be prayer, food, and fellowship so please come praise God at mass and visit the altar after. I am grateful to all of those who help make that altar a reality, it takes a great deal of work!

Finally, we congratulate our 54 young men and women who received the Sacrament of Confirmation. We keep all of them in our prayers as they continue to discern God's will in their lives and ask the help of the Holy Spirit to follow that will. I thank everyone who helped plan the Confirmation Mass.
