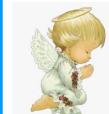

Dear Parish Family,

I am grateful to all those who joined our Holy Hour and rosary this past Monday for our country. As Election Day ends and the results are announced, we pray for our country and our leaders, we pray for those newly elected leader that they may enact laws that continue to build up the dignity of the human person. As we finish this election season, I cannot help but think about Pope Francis' encyclical *All Brothers*.

As a Church and nation, we are polarized and divided. But our Holy Father suggests, we can seek "a better kind of politics, one truly at the service of the common good." We *must* be reminded that the virtue of charity is at the heart of our faith. We *must* affirm through our words and actions the dignity of *every person*, because every person is made in God's image and likeness. Remember, Christ asks us to love as He does, even our enemies. Again, we pray for our newly elected leaders and continue to pray for our country.

Looking ahead, December 9th will be a Holy Day of Obligation this year. The Holy Day of the Immaculate Conception typically occurs on December 8th, but that falls on a Sunday this year. So, the Solemnity is transferred to the Monday. In the past, the United States Bishops removed the obligation to attend Mass. However, the Vatican recently informed the bishops that it is still a Holy Day of Obligation.

So, our Mass schedule for Monday, December 9th will be the following:

7 a.m. at St. Joseph in Iota

6 p.m. at St. Michael in Egan

There will be *no* evening Mass the day before on Sunday, December 8th. The Sunday Mass schedule remains the same and does not fulfill the Holy Day for Monday as those masses are in the morning. Please help spread the word that this is now a Holy Day of Obligation.

Recently, the nails in the roof of St. Joseph Hall were replaced with new nails.
