As we continue along the month of November, our reflection on the Four Last Things continues. The next area of reflection is judgment, which is connected to death. We believe that immediately after our death, each person is judged by God based on his or her conduct in this life, and goes either to Heaven, Hell, or Purgatory. We refer to this as our Particular Judgment.

At the end of the world, however, Christ will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead. This is known as the Final Judgment. We do not know the time or the hour, which is why we must always be prepared for Christ's coming.

Many of you may have noticed a few changes to the adoration chapel. Over the next few weeks, I hope to renovate our chapel, especially during this Year of the Eucharistic Revival.

Have you ever bought something, brought it home, and taken it out of the box only to find that the directions were not included in the package? The lack of directions makes whatever you're trying to do harder to complete because you have no guidance.

The same is true for the ways and things of God. Without seeking some direction (from God, a friend, or a priest or pastor, or a spiritual director), it is much harder to discern what God is intending the "package" that is your life to be or accomplish.

Spiritual direction could more aptly be termed spiritual accompaniment. The goal of spiritual direction is not only to helps us to discern exactly what it is that God is calling us to do in our lives in moments big or small, but also to have someone to walk the journey with you in drawing closer to the Lord.

I am currently working on obtaining a Spiritual Direction certificate from Divine Mercy University in Sterling, Virginia. I have been in the program for about 2 years now and I am currently working on my practicum. This portion of the program requires me to get 48 hours of spiritual direction experience with directees. I am currently taking on new directees as part of my coursework, and, after completing my coursework, this is a service that I will offer to the parish.

Whether we are discerning a vocation or just trying to grow closer to God. It is a great resource and one that I would encourage you to avail yourself of. After all, when you have directions, getting the most out of whatever is in the package is much easier.
