As we continue through the month of November, we continue to pray for the Holy Souls in Purgatory. We also continue our reflection on the Four Last Things. Our reflection today will be on the topic of Heaven, Hell, and Purgatory. At the moment of our death, we are judged by God based on our conduct in life, and we then go to our reward or punishment.

Heaven is the eternal state of perfect happiness resulting from the face-to-face vision of God. Hell is the eternal state of torment and despair which awaits those who reject God and the happiness He offers. Our goal, of course, is Heaven! Purgatory is an intermediate state where those who are bound for heaven undergo a temporary period of purifying suffering. When this purification is complete, they are fit to enter God's presence.

This upcoming week we also have the Presentation of the Virgin Mary, which celebrates Mary being presented in the Temple, which was a common custom for the Jewish people. In the Gospel of Luke, St. Joseph and Mary present Christ. So, it can be assumed that Sts. Anna and Joachim presented Mary as well. This celebration emphasizes the holiness conferred on Mary from the beginning of her conception. It is uniquely related to the Immaculate Conception and her birth.

We also celebrate the Memorial of St. Cecilia, the patron saint of musicians! We pray for our choir as they continue to lead us in praise and adoration of God!
