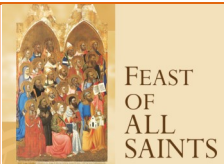


Vocation Cross

All Saints Day is Sunday, November 1st. All weekend Masses will be celebrated for the Feast of All Saints. We will have the **Blessing of the Cemetery**— The blessing will be held **Sunday, November 1st.** Sensat Cemetery, Egan will be after the 9AM Mass; St. Joseph Cemetery will be after the 11 AM Mass, the Iota Cemetery (Town), right after.



All Souls Day Mass - will be Monday, November 2nd at 8AM in the Mausoleum.

Again this year we will use a 7 day candle to remember our loved ones. The candles will be \$5.00 each and a maximum of three lines with up to two names per line can be placed on each candle.
