Dear Parish Family,

As *Respect Life Month* soon comes to an end, we are one more reminded of the immense importance of human dignity. How it can never be removed, and how every human person should be treated with respect and even reverence. Christ dwells, in a mysterious way, in all people as we are all created in God's image and likeness. Whether they are a different race, religion, political affiliation, creed, or whatever may differentiate us, that doesn't mean we should treat them with animosity. We proclaim the Truth, Jesus Christ crucified and risen from the dead, but we proclaim the Truth in charity because without charity our words are empty.

As a reminder, we will have Burgers and Bingo this Sunday, October 27<sup>th</sup> at St. Francis School. As we get closer to Halloween, I always see Christians denounce every aspect of it as evil. As Catholics, we should not have this attitude toward Halloween. Another name for Halloween is All Hallows' Eve, which is the day before All Hallows, also known as All Saints' Day. The word "hallow" means "holy" or "saint," think of the Our Father when we pray, "...hallowed be thy name..." The word "hallowed" means "holy," we are not making God's name holy by praying, but rather declaring it as holy!

So, Halloween has deep Catholic roots that date back to the 600s or so. Sadly, Halloween now has been commercialized in an extreme way and falsely claimed by Neo-paganism, who think it has its roots in pagan winter festivals. All Hallows' Eve is meant to be a day of fasting and preparation for All Saints' Day. So, we can still celebrate it by trick or treating or watching a scary movie, but keep in mind that our focus will always be on heavenly realities.

Looking ahead, November 1<sup>st</sup> is a Holy Day of Obligation. We will have a 6 p.m. at St. Michael on October 31<sup>st</sup>, and then an 8 a.m. and 12:05 p.m. at St. Joseph on the day. We will also have our All Souls' Mass in the St. Joseph Mausoleum on November 2<sup>nd</sup> at 7 a.m. Cemetery blessings will take place after the 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. on Sunday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>, I will explain more about the plenary indulgence next weekend since it can be gained throughout the entire month of November.
