This week, we will celebrate All Hallows' Eve (Halloween), All Saint's Day, and all Soul's Day! This time used to be called Allhallowtide or Hallowtide. The name simply denotes a few days of celebration and prayer. I like to look at these three days this way. Halloween, though it has now become commercialized, is connected to All Saint's Day. It was once called All Hallow's Eve, the word "hallow" here means holy. It is a reminder for us, here on earth, to be good and holy, and to honor those who have died.

All Saint's Day allows us to reflect on those men, women, and children who have made it into heaven. We celebrate their accomplishments and long to be with them all, those named and unnamed, in heaven! Finally, All Soul's Day allows us to reflect on our mortality and pray for our loved ones who have died.

In celebration, we will have the blessings of cemeteries after the 9 a.m. at St. Michael and after the 11 a.m. at St. Joseph. There will be a Tuesday evening All Saints Mass at 6 p.m. at St. Michael and then an 8 a.m., with the St. Francis students, and a 12:15 at St. Joseph. On November 2nd there will be a mass in the cemetery at 7 a.m.

On November 3rd there will be a health screening at the Parish Hall provided by Any Lab Test Now. They will offer various selections of preventative tests for a fee.
