This past week we celebrated the Memorial of Blessed Francis Xavier Seelos. A German Redemptorist, who traveled to the United States to minister to German speaking immigrants. He dedicated his life to parish ministry and preaching. He was known for his kindness and responding to the needs of those entrusted to his care. In 1866, he was assigned to a parish in New Orleans during the height of the yellow fever epidemic. After weeks of visiting and taking care of the sick, he contracted the illness and died. His cause is still open, so we ask for his intercession, especially for the sick in our parish and community. Blessed Francis Xavier Seelos, pray for us!

This Wednesday, we will celebrate a Mass for Vocations with St. Francis School. First, we pray for all those who continue to follow God's call to holiness in their marriages, consecrated life, priesthood, and religious life. Second, we pray for those who are discerning God's will. If anyone has any questions about vocations or discernment, please do not hesitate to contact me.

Looking Ahead:

At the end of the month, we will celebrate the great Solemnity of All Saints, which reminds us that our home is in Heaven. It is a Holy Day of Obligation. Our mass schedule is as follows:

Wednesday – November 1st at 8 a.m. and 12:15 (St. Joseph)

November 2nd we will have an All Soul's Day Mass in the cemetery at 7 a.m. The weekend before, October 29th, there will be a blessing of the graves. After the 9 a.m. at St. Michael, I will bless the Sensat Cemetery, and after the 11 a.m., I will bless our cemetery at St. Joseph. This is a beautiful tradition of our Church to pray for those who have died.


Advent - Are you ready?


